

NCTTA is looking for Regional Directors for the 2011-2012 Season

Help coordinate 3-6 NCTTA Divisions in your region

As a Regional Director you can:

- Learn to develop and apply leadership skills
- Have an opportunity to significantly impact the growth of college table tennis in North America
- Work in close collaboration with other RDs and the NCTTA board
- Receive a complimentary invitation to the national championships, all expenses paid (may need to serve as a volunteer based on need)
- Become a USATT certified referee, paid for by NCTTA

What do Regional Directors do?

- Oversee and manage a region of 3-6 NCTTA divisions with a certain amount of autonomy
- Stay in close communication with the Division Directors in their division to make sure things run smoothly in their region
- Plan and coordinate the Regional Championship for division winners in their region
- Help recruit new schools within their region to grow their region and college table tennis
- Are allocated an annual budget for use within their region and for their Regional Championship
- Attend at least half of NCTTA board meetings (online) throughout the year

What are the qualifications and requirements?

- Must be a current or former Division Director with 2 years experience or demonstrate equivalent experience
- Have active NCTTA Division Director certification (can certify before starting as Regional Director, if necessary)
- Must be a USATT Certified Referee (can certify before starting as Regional Director, if necessary)

- Basic computer proficiency, including word processing, spreadsheets, and email
- Good organizational and time management skills, good attention to detail
- Ability to stay calm in the rare stressful situation

Regional Directors are needed for the following regions:

- **South Region** (Texas, Dixie, Georgia, Panhandle, South/Central Florida)
- o Great Lakes Region (Michigan, Northern Ohio, Upstate NY, Eastern Canada 1 & 2)
- Midwest Region (Southern Ohio, Upper Midwest, Minnesota, Lower Midwest, Kansas)
- Mid Atlantic Region (Carolina, Virginia, DC, Atlantic, Jersey Shore)
- o Northeast Region (NYC Metro, Tri-State, New England 1 & 2)
- West Region (Northern California, Northwest, Rocky Mountain, Southern California)
