MEETING FACILITIES & SPACES

Great spaces make great meetings.

The Albuquerque Convention Center, New Mexico's premier meeting space, is a versatile facility. Located in the heart of downtown, this SMG-managed Convention Center is a high-tech facility which includes a total of 600,000 sq. feet. Albuquerque has unconventional spaces for extraordinary meetings. This includes a selection of unique meeting and event venues such as the National Hispanic Cultural Center, the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center, Civic Plaza, the National Atomic Museum, the Anderson-Abruzzo Albuquerque International Balloon Museum and many more to choose from.

MEETING FACILITIES

ALBUQUERQUE CONVENTION CENTER

A total of 600,000 square feet includes 168,000 square feet of exhibit space, 29 meeting rooms, 2,400-seat auditorium and 31,164 square foot ballroom.

ALBUQUERQUE BIOLOGICAL PARK

The Albuquerque Aquarium can accommodate 150 people seated and 400 total year round.

The Rio Grande Botanic Gardens can accommodate 250 people seated and 2,000 total May thru Sept. **The Rio Grande Zoo** has catering capacity for 4,000 people with seating for 2,000 available May thru Sept.

ALBUQUERQUE LITTLE THEATRE

Auditorium and stage can accommodate 480 people for a performance, presentation or conference.

THE ALBUQUERQUE MUSEUM OF ART & HISTORY

Meeting capacity for 10 to 80 people. For social events the Reception Area can accommodate up to 450 people, the Sculpture Garden accommodates 500, the Amphitheater accommodates 400, and the entire museum can accommodate up to 1,000.

ANDERSON-ABRUZZO ALBUQUERQUE INTERNATIONAL BALLOON MUSEUM

Located by Balloon Fiesta Park. Can accommodate business meetings up to 50 people. Can accommodate banquets, weddings, and special events up to 225 people seated, 500 informal inside the museum and 1,000 including indoor and outdoor spaces.

EXPLORA SCIENCE CENTER & CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

Various indoor spaces to accommodate 30 to 1000 people. Multiple outdoor decks and patios can accommodate up to 400 people each. Entire building and grounds holds 2500.

EXPO NEW MEXICO (NM State Fairgrounds)

Has various private buildings ranging from 3,894 to 29,282 square feet available for meetings, events, and tradeshow. Grounds include the Tingley Coliseum that accommodates up to 12,000 people. Catering and entertainment available.

GOLFERNOGGINS INDOOR MINI GOLF

Meeting area can accommodate 60+ people. Video projection system and on and offsite catering. Mini golf course and Wii game room available for team building.

INDIAN PUEBLO CULTURAL CENTER

15 Meeting rooms and outdoor spaces that can accommodate groups up to 5500 people. The Pueblo Harvest Café inside of the IPCC offers on-site catering and includes a 2,086 sq ft main dining room and a 1,200 covered patio on the main floor and 708 sq ft private dining, 1,000 sq ft public dining, and 450 balcony seating on the second floor.

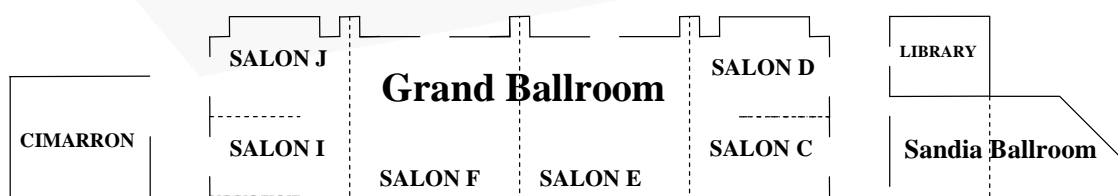

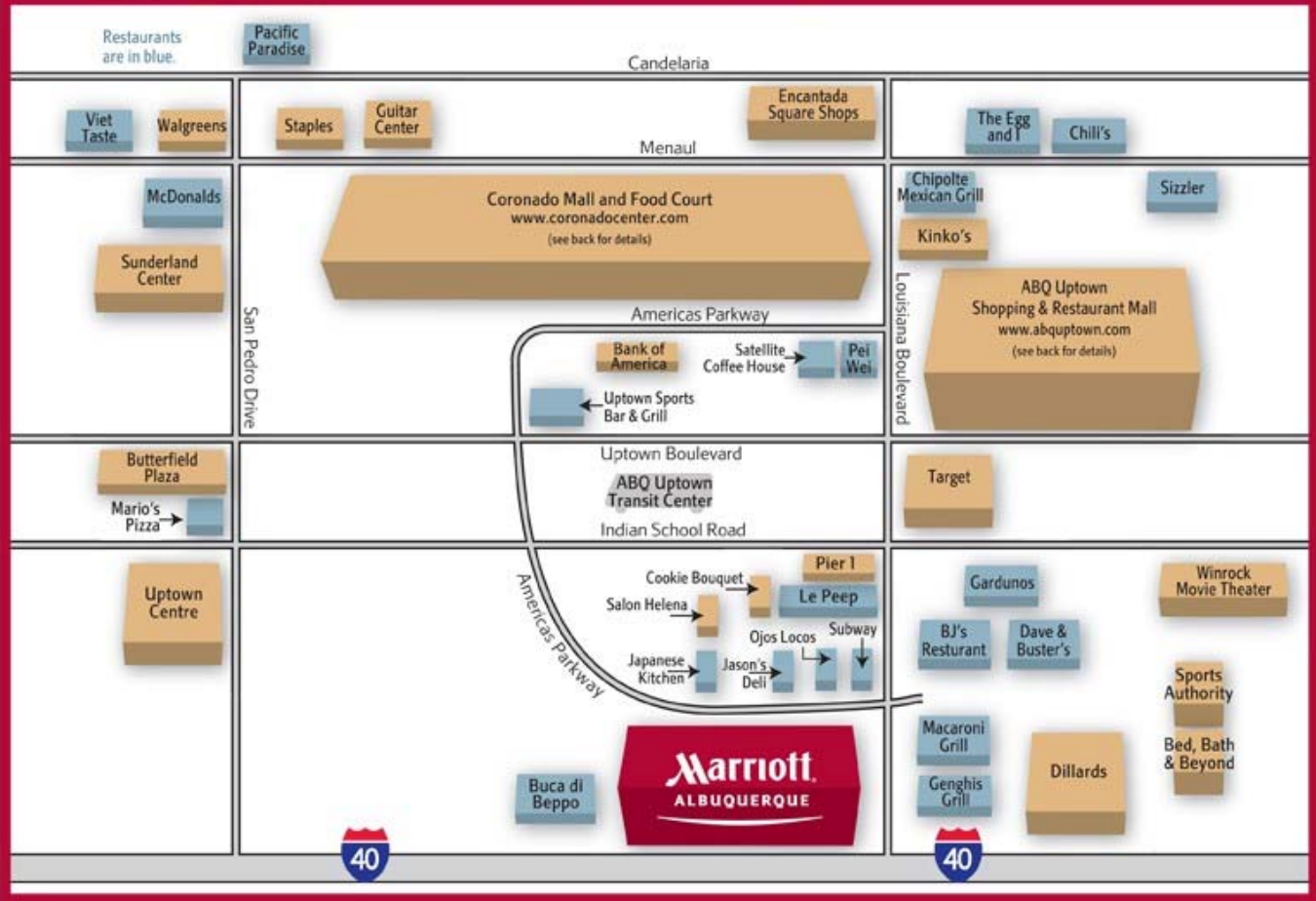

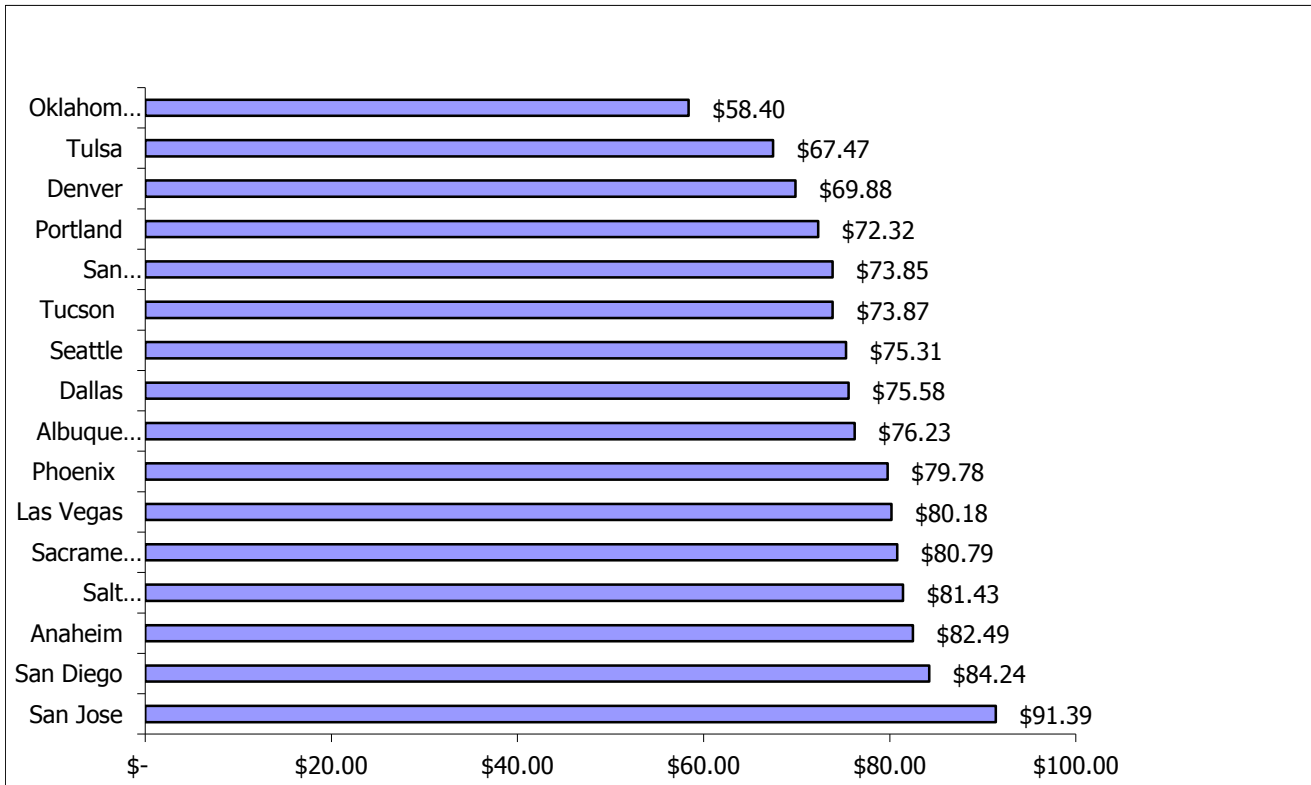

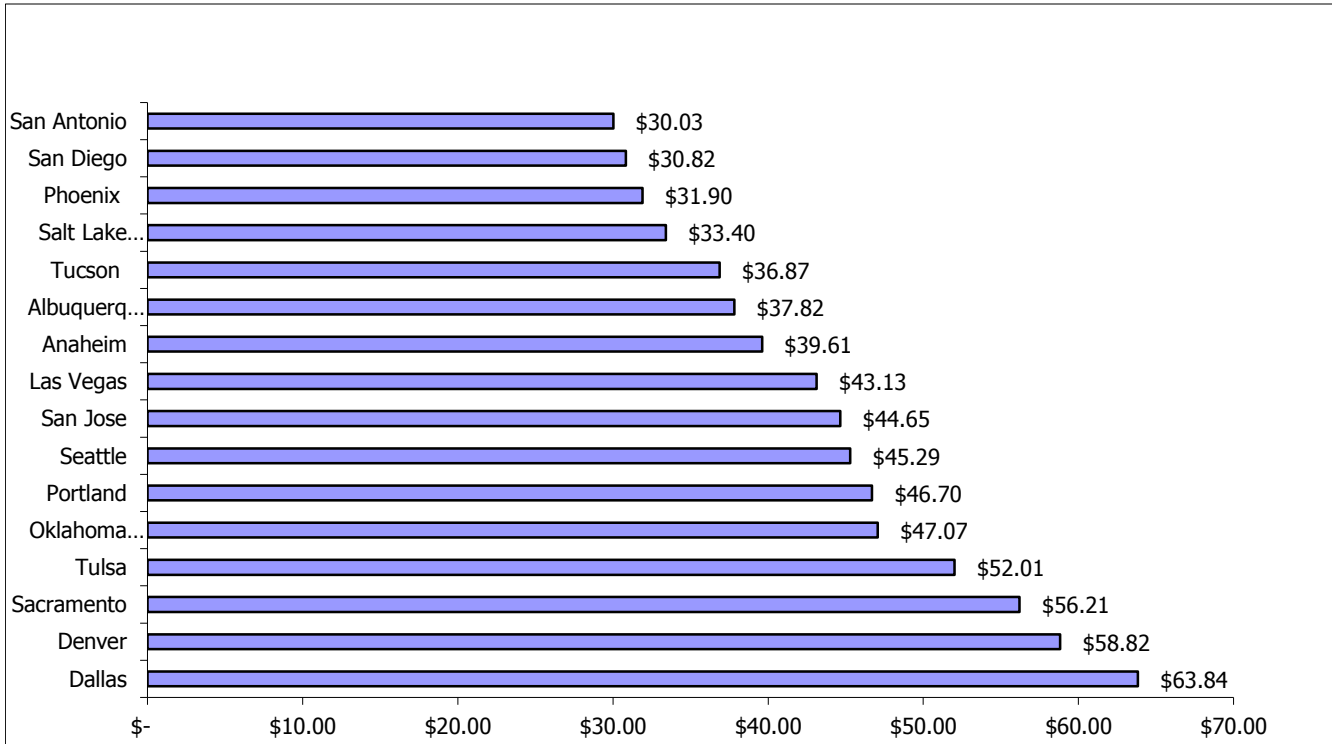

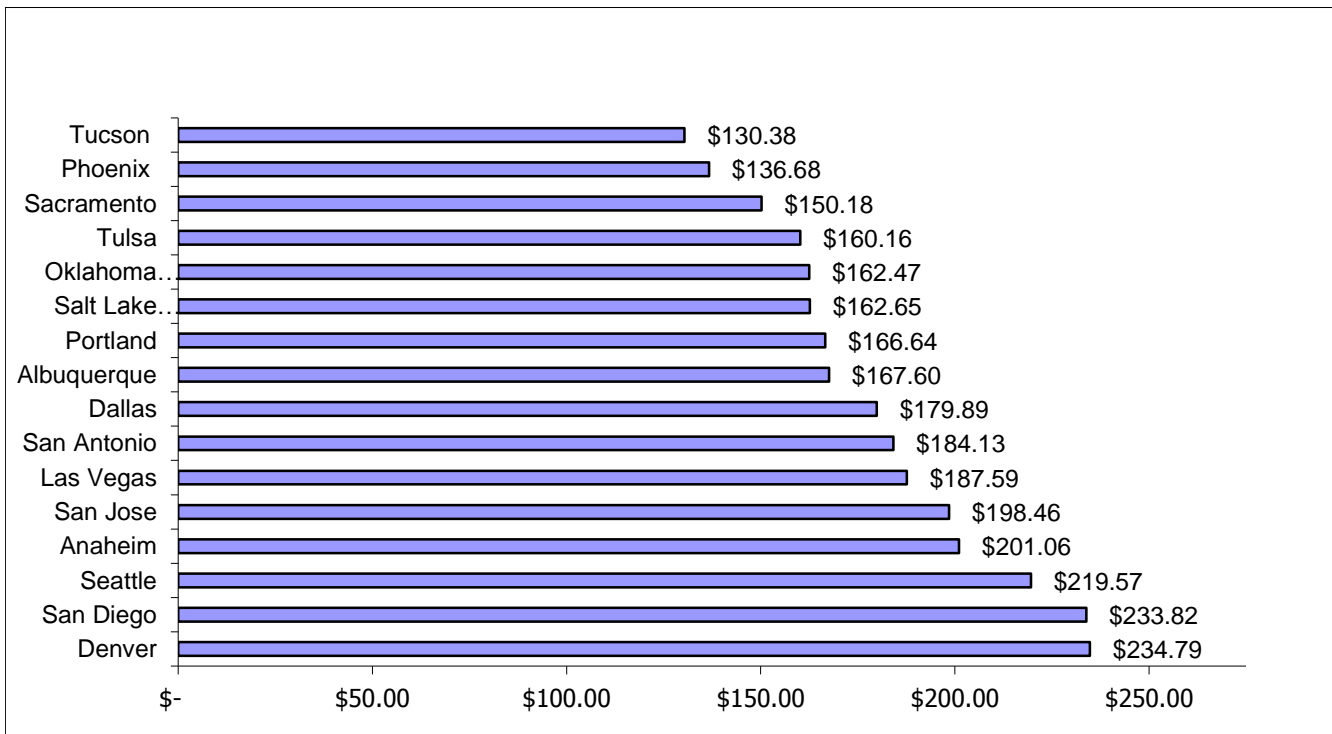
Daily Total Spent on Three Meals
