Wildcard Example for Teams Going to Regionals

	Step 1 - All Division winners are invited.
	Step 2 - Divisions of 6 or more qualify their 2nd place team.
	Step 3 - All other 16 teams are ranked in descending order and the highest 2 are selected to fill out a total of 8 teams.

Notes:

(i) In Division 2, the winning Team H cannot afford to travel to Regionals so the 2nd place finisher was invited and accepted.

Wildcard Example for Singles Going to Regionals

	Step 1 - Top 4 finishers in all 4 Divisions are invited (see Notes).
	Step 2 - All other 24 players are ranked in descending order and the highest 8 are selected to fill out a total of 24 singles players.

Notes:

(i) Player 2 has broken their leg and can't compete at Regionals so the 5th place finisher (Player 5) was invited instead.

(ii) Player 13 has a wedding to go to on the weekend of Regionals and rejects our invitation so the 5th place finisher (Player 16) was invited instead.

(iii) Player 15 turns us down so the 6th place finisher (Player 17) was invited instead, but he turns us down also. That ends the automatic qualifier invitations for Division 2. Wildcards are invited.

(iv) Player 26 turns us down so the 5th place finisher (Player 27) accepts.
